

BASICS OF WORKING IN YOUR PATH

There are some important things to know as you begin your path.

Levels and Project Completion Order

Pathways is designed to be completed sequentially by level, starting with Level 1 and ending with Level 5; Each level builds on the previous one. Projects in subsequent levels cannot be accessed until you have completed the previous level.

Level	Project Completion Order
1	You must begin with the <i>Ice Breaker</i> . You can work on the other projects in this level in any order.
2, 3, 4	Once each level is reached, you can work on the projects in the level in any order.
5	Once you are in the final for your path, you can work on the first two projects in any order. You must complete the <i>Reflect on your Path</i> project last.

Level 1 Projects – The projects in this level are the same for all paths.

Level 1	Project Requirements
Ice Breaker	• Give a 4-6 minute speech on any topic to introduce yourself to the club.
Evaluation and Feedback	 Give a 5-7 min speech on any topic. Give a 2nd 5-7 min speech, using feedback from the 1st speech. It's recommended to repeat the 1st speech; it's also recommended to use the same evaluator. Serve as a speech evaluator. There is an evaluation form for this and it is recommended that the evaluator give a speech about your evaluation.
Researching and Presenting	• Research any topic and give a 5-7 minute speech.

Path Flow – This is the basic flow as you work through the levels in your path.



Once all projects in a level have been completed, submit the Level Completion request. The Base Camp Manager must approve this before you can begin the next level. To receive the education award after completing a level, (and for it to show in your club's DCP), the award must be submitted in Club Central by your VPE or other club officer.

NOTE: Let your VPE know if you prefer to have your Level award submitted in Club Central at another time or submitted through another club.
